A barbecue brunch for ex-students will be held on the school oval from 11 am to 2.30 pm on Sunday, March 17.

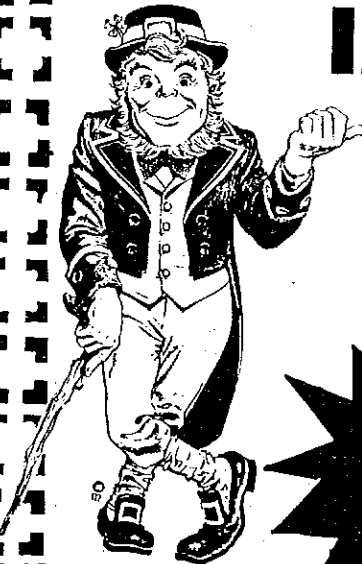
